

Analysis of Training Measures and - Programmes as well as
further Training for Professionals

For the Federal Republic of Germany we so far analysed the educational and further training's measures and programmes in the problem field of sexual exploitation of children as per the following:

1.1 Manfred Paulus and Prof. Adolf Gallwitz

**Manfred Paulus is Primary Police-Chief-Superintendent (retired).
He is professor at the Police Academy in Baden-Württemberg.**

Professor Adolf Gallwitz is a qualified Medical and Police-Psychologist. He studied pedagogics, medical and psychological-sciences. Since 1992 he is professor of psychology, sociology and dean of the faculty Social Sciences at the Police-University of Villingen-Schwenningen in Baden-Württemberg. He is an active teacher (at the Police-Academy and assistant-professor at the University of Konstanz), a psychological consultant, a referee e.g. at the International Court in Den Haag), a trainer (leading skills, missions abroad, human recourse-management in extreme situations, interrogation-psychology) and in research (credibility, sexual deviation, forensic psychology, psycho-path metrics) and co-initiator and co-operator in nationwide campaigns considering sexual violence and in criminal-prevention-activities of local authorities) as well as a member of the children's protection initiative Hänsel und Gretel.

Manfred Paulus and Professor Adolf Gallwitz are authors of different manuals of the subject sexual violence against children.

The following trainings measures and – programmes for different professionals are offered by Manfred Paulus and Professor Adolf Gallwitz among others for police, political groups, parents, teachers, pedagogues, NGOs, church organisations, educational organisations, multipliers who are in the respective children's responsibilities.

1.1.1 Sexual exploitation of children and trafficking of children (emphasis: Eastern Europe)

- **Explanation of crime supporting / crime preventing behaviour**
- **Criminals' profiles / best actions**
- **Victims' profiles / victims' behaviour / victims' aftermath**

The training measures are on the basis of long-term criminal-police experiences with respective knowledge of criminals and victims as per the circumstances of the offence in lectures and/or discussions in order to achieve effective prevention.

1.1.2 Human trafficking and red-light-crime, women's trafficking, sexual exploitation, organised crime (emphasis: Eastern Europe)

- **Prevention work in the recruiting countries of Eastern and Southern Europe.**
- **Regular exchange of experiences of the criminal militia in order to gain intelligence and to hinder respective crime.**
- **Prevention work in Germany with recruitment – sluicing/trafficking - exploitation**
- **Course of crime and methods**
- **Criminals, groups of criminals, syndicates**
- **Victims of the sub-culture in the red-light milieu**
- **Structures and specials of the prostitutes' milieus**
- **Investigation, prosecution, dark field**
- **Legal politics' demands**

These trainings' measures include the build-up and build-out of cooperation of all the participating countries (police and NGOs), intelligence of investigation in the scene of crime, methods, realization of crime, „exit” offers, cutback of prejudice by lectures and/or discussions in Germany and Eastern Europe. Also in these fields there are long-term criminal-police experiences of investigation as well as good knowledge of the situation in the Eastern European recruiting countries (the basis are assignments of the European Commission)

2.1 ECPAT Deutschland e.V. in cooperation with ECPAT Netherlands, Defence for Children International Netherlands and ECPAT International

ECPAT is a workgroup to protect children against sexual abuse. It's a nationwide operating coalition of 28 institutions and groups. Basic principle of the group (located in Freiburg, Breisgau) and of all member-organisations is that every child deserves complete protection against all kinds of commercial exploitation and sexual abuse. ECPAT Deutschland stands for maintenance of the children's-rights of the UN, to exhibit the reasons for disregards, and to sue all violations with all available resources.

ECPAT Deutschland is engaged in different fields (politics, justice, economy and education) and performs campaigns and projects in cooperation with governmental and non-governmental organisations to sensitize the public, to develop prevention-measures and to get basic-legal-rights for the protection of children. In close connection with the tourism-branch the "Code of conduct" will be performed, which shall protect children from being sexually abused in tourism (such as child-prostitution). Furthermore ECPAT supports the entire political performance of the action-plan, which 1996 was signed by 122 countries in Stockholm at the 1st. World congress against commercial sexual abuse of children. This action-plan describes extensive strategies and measures for the protection of children against commercial sexual exploitation. All countries were challenged to explore certain national programmes. Germany has signed an action-plan in 2003.

Besides promoting and observing the maintenance of the UN children's rights, ECPAT is also engaged in the development assistance and -measures for the protection of minors against sexual exploitation and for their rehabilitation. These goals are mostly achieved by advanced education and publicity, by cooperation in international development and by communication between nationalities.

ECPAT offers the following training-measures and -programmes for different subjects:

2.3. Joint venture of child-protection-centres in Germany

The child-protection-centre is primarily established as consulting-centre for families with violence-problems, specially focussed on physical and mental maltreatment, child neglect and sexual abuse.

- Goal and task

- o To decrease, to prevent and to stop the violence against children, the child mistreatment, the child neglect and their sexual abuse

- by developing, practicing and communicating special aids, focussed on the reason for violence
- Task fields

- Working with affected families or with single family members
 - Crisis intervention
 - Phone consultation
 - Consultation / therapy for children and parents
 - Providing the connection to social consultation and aids
 - Social pedagogical family aid
 - Accommodation-biddings for children
 - Working with abusers

- Working with experts

- **Consulting, organising and performing aid-conferences**
- **Coordinating and net-working help-offers**
- **Accompaniment in practice, supervision of workers of other psychosocial institutions**
- **Advanced training by seminars and events**
 - **Extra-occupational advanced trainings to receive the degree of a qualified worker relevant to § 8a SGBVIII and for consulting a case-coordination as a method of helping youth in the case of child-welfare jeopardizing**
- **Coordination and Net-working**

- Prevention and public relation

2.4. Bundesarbeitsgemeinschaft Kinder- und Jugendschutz e.V.

(Federal work-group for Children'- and Youth'-protection e.V.)

Founded 1951 the BAJ is focussed on the rights and needs of children and youth and operates above party lines and yet it is governmental. It supports their interests in the public and initiates measures for the protection of children and youth. It informs teachers in schools, kindergartens and youth-support institutes about current laws and rules, performs public campaigns.

On one side children and youths shall be protected against jeopardizing, on the other side they shall be able to manage hazardous situations themselves and to be critical.

- Areas of action

- structural protection of children and youth
- Educational protection of children and youth, to empower the competence of children and youth and to strengthen adults to protect children and youth better against jeopardizing influences.
- Controlling the regulatory instruments to protect children and youth
 - Information about existing laws and rules, to improve them in cooperation with the society and accountable persons, but also to really act according to them

- Biddings

- **Seminaries and expert-meetings considering the topic protection of youth, prevention of violence and sexual pedagogy**

2.5. Deutsche Gesellschaft gegen Kindesmisshandlung und –vernachlässigung

The “German association against child-abuse and – neglect” (DGgKV e.V.) is an inter-disciplinary **organisation for all experts, who are engaged in physical and mental maltreatment, sexual abuse and neglect of children.**

- Biddings:

- for interested lays, parents, children and affected persons the association offers tips and links for information and for help-biddings in the internet, considering counselling -centres and self-help-groups.
- **Extra-occupational events and advanced training for pedagogical and therapeutical experts engaged in working with maltreated and abused children, but also with adult offenders, and for physicians for children and youth**
 - **Seminars for a child-focussed prevention-planning or how to deal with young abusers, and for the psycho-therapeutical treatment of sexual offenders.**
 - **Advanced learning in modules considering “victim-focussed treatment of offenders”, starting September 2009**
 - **Biddings for advanced learning in medical diagnostic, support for diagnostical findings, and chances for cooperation**
 - **Operating nationwide to ensure and increase an appropriate treatment of victims and offenders**
 - All training-biddings are certificated by DGgKV and in addition for physicians according to the Physicians Association
- Every 2 years performing a county-wide multi-disciplinary congress for members and guests, focussed on current problems for the protection of children and youth

2.6. SUB/WAY Berlin e.V.

Subway concentrates on boys only, who prostitute themselves. Coming to them means to be engaged in topics like gay-sex, AIDS and violence.

- Biddings:

- Project: Berlin-boys against sexual abuse of boys
 - Biddings for **advanced learning / project days / lectures**
 - **First jour fixe advanced learning for multiplier**
 - Topic: sexual intrusion of boys in the public of Berlin
 - Berlin-boys shows, how offenders act in spas, shopping-centres and streets and **why it is so difficult for boys to ask for help when something has “happened”.**
- Goals
 - Identifying and naming the strategies of offenders
 - Sensitizing the subject sexual violence of boys
- **Target groups**
 - **social-pedagogues, educators and teachers**
 - **Other members and persons involved in youth-support (also trainees and students)**
 - **Policemen**
 - **Authorized educators**
- Schedule
 - Every first Wednesday from 9 am to 1 pm (if a holyday, then the 2nd Wednesday)
 - It's for free because these trainings for multipliers are financially supported by the Senate of Berlin (department education and science)

2.7 Dunkelziffer e.V. (Dark Figure e.V.) Hamburg. - Help for sexually abused children

For long this organisation has been concentrating on its work for better protection of victims, on increasing the level of penalties, on removing the taboo of this subject by press-work and by a wide enlightenment in the public.

Since 1993 Dunkelziffer e.V. has been fighting against the sexual abuse of children and against child-pornography with the tools therapy, consulting, prevention and advanced training. The projects support victims, their representatives and all who are engaged in this subject - private or occupational.

- **Dunkelziffer offers advanced trainings and consultations for people in psycho-social professions, pedagogy, justice and police**
- **In all of these working-areas the subject sexual abuse can occur in their daily work**
- **Target of the advanced training is to empower the competence in handling affected persons and to demonstrate possibilities of prevention**
- The trainings can be single-term only or repeated, and can be performed as single- or group-training, just as demanded
- Content, duration and location of the trainings will be organized according to the needs of the target group.
- Dunkelziffer e.V. offers internet-seminars for policemen, attorneys and judges involved in the battle against child-pornography in the internet. Dunkelziffer e.V. has already trained more than 1000 persons nationwide
- **Advanced training for judges**
 - **Participating judges of the internet-seminaries often complain that there are no additional trainings in the subject child-abuse for this group of professionals.**
 - **To ensure the protection of victims during the witness-questioning there is a need for additional training of judges**
 - Often the young witnesses have lost their trust in adults and suffer by fear in court
 - A trained judge has more chances to communicate with the children
 - Therefore, Dunkelziffer e.V. offers special seminars from 2008. They should ease and help in preparation and performance of the procedure and give advice how to cooperate sensitively with the innocent victims.
- **General expert-events**

All events must be paid, because the organisation is only financed by donations and contributions and receives no public payment

 - Strohthalm offers nationwide advanced trainings (and lectures) for the carriers of the free and public youth-welfare, and for teams and committees, considering the following subjects
 - Sexual abuse of girls and boys
 - Sexual abuse is one of the centre subjects for child-protection and demands expert knowledge and sensibility for all experts of the free and public youth-welfare
 - In these advanced trainings elementary knowledge considering sexual abuse will be discussed: definitions, data, the strategies of offenders, the dynamic of abuse, the defend-mechanisms of the victims, the pedagogical treating in the case of suspect
 - **Possibilities to prevent sexual abuse**
 - **“Adults are accountable for the protection of children” is the guideline** for the prevention against sexual abuse. With the help of examples the participants will understand and learn how to eliminate the points of contact for the offenders and how to empower the self-esteem of the children. Lots of examples and materials will be provided for the work in practice
 - Sexual intrusions between children
 - Educators often feel uneasy if they notice sexual intrusion between children. “What is normal? And what shall I do when I notice sexual intrusion between children?”
 - After clarifying what sexual activities between children means, a definition will be discussed what sexual intrusion is, taken as basement for the intension to protect children. With some examples the appropriate handling of the victim and the intruding child will be introduced.
 - One focus is the subject, which measures must be taken in this case. The chances and the difficulties of communicating with all involved persons (the victim, the intruder, the team, the supervisor, the parents) will be discussed

The focus of all trainings will be arranged according to the needs.

3.0 Bundesarbeitsgemeinschaft Prävention und Prophylaxe

The BAG Prevention und Prophylaxis e.V. in Berlin, exists since 1998 and is nationwide and in some European countries active and linked. The federation is financed only by its members, by donations and by selling publications. All workers are engaged voluntary; authors give their publications for free.

- Publications in special literature, special magazines and newsletters as well as in special books for children
- Managing a special pedagogical information centre
- Nationwide cooperation with special institutes and organisations and with some countries in Europe and South-America
- Exchange of experiences in several groups with the focus “prevention”
- Biddings:
 - Compact-offerings for parents, children and **educators to prevent sexual abuse**
 - Self-esteem courses for children considering questions like:
 - Is a child honestly stronger than an elder/adult offender?
 - Is it clever enough to know the tricks of the offender?
 - Do you really want a child to fight against a stronger person?
 - Do you guess what that could mean?
 - Do you frighten your child about offender?
 - How long do you believe will your child remember the contents of the course?

3.1. Stiftung Hänsel und Gretel Charitable Foundation Hansel and Gretel

Ever since its foundation in 1997 the charitable organisation has initiated and supported children’s protective projects, which offer direct and indirect help to abused children. Likewise their task is to work for a better children’s lobby. They operate **net-work** for families, parents, **teachers, educational experts, magistrates, medicals and police** in order to support them.

Offers

- Victims’ protection – to prevent further trauma by video-hearing-rooms suitable for children
- **Since 1998 the Charitable Foundation Hansel and Gretel has furnished more than 35 video-hearing-rooms suitable for children all over Germany. The video documentation is essential in the victims’ protection. It is proved that the children’s testify with more authenticity, which strengthens the possibility of a later criminal’s sentence already during the preliminary investigation and often saves the children’s further hearing in court.**
- Prevention of children’s abuse in the “dark field”, “Avoid committing” in **cooperation with the Charité Hospital in Berlin**
- The Charitable Foundation Hansel and Gretel support the **scientific project “Prevention of sexual children’s abuse in the dark field” by the Charité Hospital, Berlin**. Since 2005 men can get there therapy-places, when their sexual phantasies aim at children, but they do not want to abuse and look for therapeutical help.
- Children’s protection by sensitization and information – look with closer attention and act
- Children get to know about their help-line quite late. So there is a movie “Der Schrei/The Outcry” which is a “daily story”... Also the short movie “Lulaland” will sensitize to realize abuse in the personal area and to act. Those films form the basis for **discussions in schools and universities**.

3.2. Wildwasser e.V.

The organisation Wildwasser e.V. (wildwater) is focussed on girls and women confronted with sexual abuse, but also on friends and family members. Nationwide it has offices in many towns.

- Biddings
 - Information and help
 - Prevention
 - Online consultation
 - Support of witnesses

3.3. Deutscher Kinderschutzbund (DKSB)

Founded 1953, today more than 50.000 members are active in 420 local offices – making this Association (children protection alliance) to the biggest in Germany. In cooperation with 10 000 volunteers and about 3000 employees the alliance is concentrated on the needs of children and **against irregularities, and impels politicians and administrations to act - and involve themselves.**

The DKSB wants to empower children, to develop their abilities, to respect them and to hear their voices. This way children are enabled to accountably form their own life and our entire world – also for the future.

The DKSB concerns on all children in Germany, with no means about their religion, gender, origin, handicaps etc. It actively fights against every kind of unfairness, discrimination and social exclusion, not only of children, but of all humans. Because only in a society identified by frankness, tolerance, peaceful living-together, equity, comprehension and solidarity, children will have a good future.

- **Focuses**

- Strong parents – strong children
 - Parents shall be empowered to concentrate on their good abilities and to give their children the safety they need for a good development.
- Parents phone
 - The parents' phone can be used by everybody, who has questions about education or who has problems with children. The federal phone # (for free) can be used Monday + Wednesday from 9 – 11 o'clock am and Tuesday and Thursday from 5 – 9 o'clock **pm**
- Children protection centre
 - The children protection centres give shelter and consultation for families with violence-problems, child neglect and sexual abuse.
 - In Germany there are 21 children protection centres
- Offices for consultation
- Blue elephant
 - More than 20 houses for children offer consultation, comfort, help and events for participating and learning
- **Children and youth phone**
 - **The children and youth phone is a bidding for phone-talks and consultations for children and youth of all ages**
 - **Daily thousands of youth call to talk with somebody trustfully, without stress and time-pressure**
 - **There is no subject excluded. For really every subject they will find “an open ear”.**
 - **For sensitive questions and subject information are given for help-supplies, if the subject extends this consultation**
 - **Children and youth can call this phone from everywhere in Germany by dialling 0800 111 0 333**
 - **The call is for free and without any time limitation, either by using a public phone or a mobile**
 - **Special knowledge is not needed. It is important to carefully listen to the concerns and sorrows of children and youth and to be ready to talk.**

3.4. Netzwerk Kindeswohl Zwickau

On the background of the social-political goals of the Saxon government the project “network to care for children” shall contribute to promote the healthy growing-up of children, which includes body, soul and mind, and to ensure the effective protection of the children’s welfare

- Tasks
 - To support parents in their educational duties and care
 - To ensure the protection of children in risky situations by clear strategies for helping and controlling
- Strategies
 - The project supports 5 city-councils and counties in Saxon (project-offices), improves inter-disciplinary network-structures and develops and establishes binding corporate-structures for the protection of children
 - Improving and developing the network- and cooperation-structures are based on the following expertise which
 - defines the features of a functioning interdisciplinary and institutional- extending network

- names instruments for an effective design of such networks
- describes acting-profiles and by this the resulting quality modules
- presents a guideline for developing quality-standards for the network of protecting children
- the qualifications are focussed on the two following subjects:
 - looking inside the network-working (designing and fostering the network to enable a work, relating to the means and by optimizing it)
 - features for network-working (sensitizing for problem areas, informing about law basics, supporting structures for additional training to enable involved persons to act appropriate in the case of prevention or emergency)
- The children-protection-networks in Saxony specially want to take notice of early biddings for prevention. Basic for this is the inter-disciplinarily organized access to families in situations which might turn out to be critical. A precocious notice of critical situations for children, youth and families shall lead to offer earlier help on a lower level.
- Emergency file “endangered child-welfare”
 - This file shall be a manual for the practice, addressing the experts of the county Zwickau, working with families and children/youth aged below 18. The file shall support the daily work and shall give security if actions must be taken in the case of suspect that the child-welfare is endangered.

3.5. Teddybär e.V., Rodewisch

In the surrounding of one of the members a sexual abuse had happened. Confronted with this situation the family was quite helpless and lonesome and was totally left alone. Because of this experience a workgroup was founded 1995 to avoid sexual abuse of children and women. Later in May 1996 7 women founded the workgroup “Teddybär”. Two rooms as places of refuge can be used by victims and their relatives.

 - Consultation
 - Self helping groups
 - **Prevention in kindergartens and schools**
 - The game “Schön & blöd” (nice & stupid) by using the following material:
 - The book “Schön & blöd”, written by U. Enders and D. Wolters
 - “Ich sag Nein” (I say No) by Gisela Braun
 - “Anna komm” (Come Anna) by the German government
 - “Komm, Paula, trau Dich” (come Paula, dare) by the consultation-office Zerrspiegel

3.6 KARO e.V. Arbeitskreis sexueller Missbrauch und Gewalt gegen Frauen und Kinder in Plauen und im Vogtlandkreis

(Organisation for sexual abuse and violence against women children in Plauen and in Vogtland County)

Authorized persons from police, court, youth-welfare-officials in Plauen, physicians / doctors, educators, employees of NGOs and other interested people in this subject, cooperate intensively to prevent every kind of abuse of children.

The organisation takes lobby- and public-work very seriously, to increase the help of the victims and to break up the anonymity of this subject, which is until now occupied by media, and to push it close to life.

2008 the group had 10 meetings and is glad about more participants. In the group-meetings we discuss cases of special help and single-cases. **Advanced training for the group members could be performed for several subjects, such as sexual abuse of children, neglect and violence of children, any kind of endangering children via the internet, as well as the subject anonymous birth and our new baby-drop-off-box.**

The network of several working groups in Plauen and Vogtland and of co-operating institutes and organisations could be increased, with the result, that in special cases the cooperation could be realized in a quicker and easier way. In addition some successful training to preventing sexual abuse could be performed at the elementary school in Plauen

- Biddings

- Discussing special topics and information
- Performing meetings
- Offering extensive information material
- Lobby- and public-work

Due to our specific experiences of the recent years we have focussed on victims' protection. Especially the well operating protection of the victims of sexual violence against women and children is the basis of successful regeneration after all that has happened. This counts for trauma-therapy as well as the courts refurbishment.

A further focus of our efforts is the street-work, advice, and via this line care of single-cases and help for exits. The street-work takes place on three days a week in the area of the Bavarian, Czech and Saxony borders for women, children and minors in the drugs'- and prostitution scenes. We are sorry to report that there are again and again violence assaults of sex-tourists against women. Sadly, also children and minors are still obviously offered for commercial sexual abuse. Also, there is a demand of paedo-sexual tourists for partly very small children. The dark figures are enormous. Not seldom that we find women highly pregnant in the street – sometimes until very shortly before giving birth – who have to offer themselves for sexual services.

Due to these problems we consider it to be essential that work beside our actions with women, children and minors in the areas of sensitisation and publicity. We do this in form of various experts' lectures as well as several media work. Please, see further information in our annual work-programme.

Analysis of the possible attention and information
