Research

KARO e.V. wrote to 101 universities and academies which profile in humanities and law as well as medical courses and police academies.

Some universities have answered, three of them have pointed out that other institutions should give the information. For one academy (for the time being) a student answered. Nine universities and academies have answered correctly.

1) Police-Academy Villingen Schwenningen

Prof. Adolf Gallwitz offers for one semester 3-hours-seminaries on the subject "Endangering of children's well-being" for the professional Police-Officers/ Public Administration (Bachelor-studies) at the Police-Academy Villingen Schwenningen.

2) University of Applied Sciences, Potsdam

Degree-Programme „Welfare“

The Degree-Programme „Welfare“ offers 4 educational possibilities for the time being:

- Social Work (BA)
- Social Work (on-line distance studies during professional work) (BA)
- Learning and education in childhood (BA)
- Social Work, focussing on families (on-line distance studies during professional work) (MA)

Study-Concept

The studies of this faculty are coined by supporting self-determination. Multi-perspective studies are partly supported by workshop-concepts and continued by attendance during the continuing studies.

Workshop-Concept

In the workshop students of the first two elementary semesters already start to learn in a self-organized, co-operative, project-related, and problem-oriented way and to produce results. As per examples of different problems of target groups or a working field the students gain competence, which is necessary to independently understand and explain practice-orientated questions scientifically due to a general perspective. The results of their researches are publicly presented.

According to Prof. Dr. Peter Knösel, Decan of Law, These subjects do not receive any deepening if they don't get any more influence during the workshops or the projects' courses. .

3) University of Applied Sciences, Kiel

We were informed:

"Referring to your question I can inform you, that the studies of "Social Work" (BA) and the expiring diploma-studies "Social Work" of the faculty „Social Work and Health“ of the University of Applied Sciences, Kiel, can be chosen as a focus of "Gender Competences in Social Work".

In the frame of this focus module we offer a required course under the title "Deepening of Female Social Work with Women and Girls under special Social and Health Circumstances".

The subjects "Sexual Abuse, Follow-up of sexual Violence and Handling of Victims of sexual Violence" are firm items of these courses. Moreover, the subject "Gender and Violence" is also taken up in the module "Gender, Interculture, Living-Environment and Circumstances".

We understand and want „Gender“ to be covered in our faculties as a profile subject, and find the issue also in the problems and focus of „Learning and Education“ as well as „Social Help“ and „Rehabilitation and Health“..

4) University of Applied Sciences, Landshut

Since there are 200 different working fields of social work, we cannot take up all modules.

In the modules we have single presentations to superior themes. The topic Abuse and Violence belongs of my specialised focus, and is therefore picked up in many presentations.

5) University of Rostock

In our institute we pick up the topics „Children's Protection“ and „Possibilities of Help and Discovery of sexual Abuse“ in three modules during the studies to become teachers in schools for mentally handicapped children. We aim to inform on-going special education teachers – in case of suspicion of violence against children (negligence of children, physical, psychological or sexual abuse) - that they get in contact with the children's sheltering centres, or another specialized counselling in order to be able to organize a network of help,

We specify the presentations "School Prevention" (Module „Basic Questions of Pedagogics for learning-disabled Children“, ("Focussing on the Pedagogic of Maladjusted Children") and "Introduction of Pedagogics of the Mentally Disabled" (Module „Basic Questions of the Pedagogics of Mentally Disabled" [while we deal in the Mentally Disabled Pedagogics with the Subject Sexual Abuse partly also in other fields among sexuality and mental disability]).

During the new Master-Studies „Early Help by Special Education Pedagogics“ the topic is at least covered in the Module „School Prevention“ as well as in the Module "Emotional and Social Development". We give room to these topics in our studies because special education pedagogues work very often with children, who have suffered or still suffer under experiences of violence.

6) University of Applied Sciences, Dresden

In the studies of "Educational Sciences/Social Pedagogics" and "Psychology" there are selective offers in the subject of "Sexual Violence". Moreover, the Department "Equalisation" offers help and presentation on sensitisation.

7) Evangelical University of Applied Sciences, Darmstadt

The studies on „Learning and Education during Childhood“ are only to be established. The topic is integrated in Module 8, covering the law side, and in Module 2 concerning the psychology of development and the aspect of traumatization.

8) Catholic University, North-Rhine-Westfalia

We offer the following seminars at the Catholic University of NRW, Department Aachen, in the subject of „Children Protection / Sexual Abuse“:

- Children and Minors as Victims and Wrongdoers of sexual Violence – Fundamentals, Intervention and Prevention
- Sexual Violence

Generally, these topics are also covered in the following seminars:

- Protection of Violence in Families – constitutional possibilities against violence in families.
- Phenomena of Violence as a matter of Social Work.

9) University of Würzburg

I am sorry to state that I am not able to give you any satisfying information concerning all courses of the university's calendar. Due to the characteristics of the German university system it is very well possible that such a course is only occasionally offered, i.e. every four semesters but irregularly, i.e. in the frame work of a project. At our university the faculties/studies courses for these topics could be Theology, Law, Medicine, Educational Sciences for Teachers, Pedagogics, and Special Educational Pedagogics.

11) University of Marburg

Dear Mrs Schauer, [...] as per my research in the respective studies (Social Sciences, Protestant Theology, Psychology, Medicine und Educational Sciences) I was informed that modules to the topics of „Children's Protection / Sexual Abuse“ are not specially offered.

In the studies of „Psychology“ there is a presentation to the subject of traumatization of children due to sexual violence being part of the topic in a seminary of Posttraumatic Stress Disorder. [Due to your question the faculty „Psychology“ in the field of „Children- and Youths-Psychology“ plans to offer a seminary concerning your mentioned issues for the summer semester 2010.](#)

In the area of „Sociology“ is no teaching-offer for this theme-complex, which would be regularly embedded.

12) University of Applied Sciences, Ludwigshafen

In the field of Social Work we offer in the frame work of basic studies a degree programme of eight semesters „Social Work“ (Diploma) for the time being and since the winter semester 08/09 degree courses of seven semesters in modules „Social Work“ (BA). The diploma studies „Social Work“ will expire by the summer semester 2011 and will be replaced by the BA studies „Social Work“ – in connection with a consecutive Master Programme „Social Work“, which we are conceptualizing at present. Our module BA studies „Social Work“ includes 15 modules and generally qualifies for all working areas of Social Work.

The subjects „Children’s Protection / Sexual Abuse“ are not specifically fixed in defined module frames of the study programmes but can be connected during the entire studies to several modules.

During the first academic year of studies (1. and 2. semester) at least one group of students regularly works in Module 1 on the subjects of „Endangered Children“ and „Sexual Abuse“. The students for example collect data, reflect on law-suits, public, especially media topics, as well as their own pre- and half-professional realisation of the problems and they are normally also contacting organisations of social work, to understand their function-, organisation-, and working-style.

Module 8 („Conduct of Life, Crisis and Coping“) imparts social-pedagogical and psychological knowledge as well as the fundamentals of law of a professional identity, ranking, and they are aiming to cope with their intervention in cases also of endangered children and sexual abuse. Students who have passed this module, have for example the legal rights of protection in danger and violence especially also in tight social relationships and possibilities of protection by means of law.

During the 5th semester the students finish an integrated practical study-semester as a place of work experience in a field of social work. Many choose an organisation that works with children, youths and families where they are mainly addressed by the topics of „Endangered Children / Sexual Abuse“. This study-semester is prepared and reinforced during four study-semesters in the frame of presentations as well as being accompanied during the 4th – 7th semester. During these presentations the respective subjects are treated as per the scale of tasks at the practical working places and the arising questions of the students. .

13) Protestant University of Dresden

Studies of Social Work (BA):

The subjects of „Children’s Protection / Sexual Abuse“ are party covered (either by all students or just only by some of them) in the following modules:

- „Anthropology, Building up Ethnical Capacity of Judgement, Human- and Basic-Rights“ (Module 4), „Fields of Action and Exploration of Practice and Profession as well as Professional Law“ (Module 6), „Family, social Network and Microsystems“ (Module 8 [This subject was neglected here. But due to some students’ critics it is possibly taken up again in the summer semester 2010]), „Integrated Understanding of Cases and Intervention“ (Module 19)
- Elective-Deepening-Studies: „Field of Action in Education, Family and Social Advice“ (Module 17.2), „Field of Action Difference, Irregularity and Social Control concerning Administration and Justice“ (Module 17.4), „Gender- and Interculture“ (Module 18.2)
- during the Studies Generale and respective offers „Youths’ and Social Work in Praha / study-excursion“ (concerning the subjects „Roma and Sinti“, „Health“, „Advice and Work in Schools“, „Handicapped Women“, „Prostitutions- and Drug-Scene in the Czech Republic“)
- among others the Studies Generale offer (i.e. „Analyses of the Genogram“, „Case Analyses“, „Law-Workshop“)
- the Studies Generale support participation in expert conferences (i.e. „Girls’ Worlds – Girls’ Work in Saxony“)

Furthermore, it is possible for the students to employ themselves in these topics by homework, reports, excursions and during their practical work (exploring work experience as well as half-year-practical training) – the latter is accompanied by their tutor.
